Reading the StudentTracker for High Schools Detail Report

This guide will help you understand the columns of data and associated rules that are returned in the student-level detail report in StudentTracker 3.0. Below are the changes/revisions you will notice between the current StudentTracker for High Schools detail report and the new version. When your institution moves to the StudentTracker 3.0 service, you will receive this version of the detail report.

Key Changes

- The same data is returned – no change to column order or formatting.
- The new columns of data are added at the end of each row from columns *X – AI*. The description of each is shown in the table below.
- Dual enrollment and first summer enrollments and credentials are now returned. The sequence number column (column *V*) displays a value of *0* for these records.
- We have revised the logic for returning credentials so that all degree records reported by the institution are returned.
- When an enrollment record indicates that a student has graduated, it will not be returned if the award date is within 45 days of a degree record. This is intended to eliminate the duplicate rows that are currently returned.
- No row is returned when the only record Clearinghouse has received is a withdrawal (the institution did not report a valid enrollment status for the student).
- The **Degree Title** (column *T*) will contain the value *Imputed* when the Clearinghouse does not have a degree record from the institution. See the column *I* description below for more information.
